Overview

Home renovation one-stop shops (OSS) function as citizen advice and support hubs which help to increase energy renovation rates, decarbonize the private building stock, improve citizen wellbeing, combat energy poverty and facilitate the Renovation Wave in Europe. Despite their potential to play a pivotal role in greening the EU's future, most local authorities have yet to undertake the task of developing and opening their OSS. **During this EU capacity building amongst local authorities, we will address the challenges local authorities face when looking to implement OSS in their cities and municipalities.**

The event will be hands-on discussion, addressing good practices and examples of existing one-stop-shops. It will be the opportunity to look into the challenges and to discuss relevant links to energy poverty reduction, inspired by the cooperation with other stakeholders, public private partnerships and existing EU funded projects.

Who should attend and why?

Cities, regions, public authorities, policy makers, and EU-funded projects interested in setting up OSS or sustainable renovation practices within Europe.
